The Commissioner of Indian Affairs
Washington D. C.

Sir

My Physician reports that Duke the son of Windy of Rosebud Agency has one lung completely solidified and that without doubt when it begins to break up he will run down at once and loose his life. His father is very much concerned about him and wants him to die at home. As Duke speaks and understands English very well and is still strong enough I can send him through alone to Sankton Agency and his father can get him there. I would request your authority to send him at once and pay the necessary expenses not exceeding forty dollars (\$40.) from funds placed to my credit for the sending of

he having concluded not to go home at present. I desire to
take advantage of this favorable weather and would be glad
to have your authority at once by telegraph.
