Sir:

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 24th instant, enclosing copy of a communication of the 22nd instant from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, stating that the transfer of certain Sioux youths of "Sitting Bull's" band now in confinement at Fort Raudall, Dakota Territory, to Carlisle school has been authorized, and requesting that the Commanding Officer at Fort Raudall may be instructed to transfer ten of said youths to the care of Miss Fletcher, who will visit the Fort for the

purpose, and also to assist her in making the selection.

In reply, I beg to inform you that the matter has been referred to the General of the Army to comply with the request of the Commissioner of Indian Affairs.
