Sir:

George Walker, one of our Sisseton Sioux boys, was entitled to return to his Agency last fall, but as Agent Crissey was anxious he should be more proficient as a Harness maker so that he could take hold of the work of the Shop in connection with the Agency School, under my advice and the Agents, George consented to remain at Carlisle for a while longer. Since Agent Crissey's visit he has been exceedingly anxious to return to his Agency and it is undoubtedly having quite an influence on his health. I think he had better return and would request your authority

to send him and to incur the necessary
expense. If possible I would like
the authority by Telegraph so he might
accompany Agent Crissey.
