Respectfully forwarded.
Before the close of last
school year I gave our
teachers to understand that
we would increase the
school room work to 3 or
3 1/2 hours in the fore-
noon and afternoon, and
add one more study hour
evening each week. At
the beginning of this sch-
-ool year the increase was
made to 3 hours forenoon
and afternoon and Thursday
evening was added as a
study hour, making 4 study
hour evenings each week.
With this understanding
Miss Botsford continued in
our service. Miss Bots-
ford is a good teacher,
but is not in the best of
health.

The best interests of
the pupils would be served
by adding another half
hour to the forenoon and
afternoon sessions. With
these statements I ask for
