1. Are you married and if so to whom? I am married to Nancy Lee, a full blood Arapaho, attended Reservation School.
2. What is your present address? Bridgeport, Okla.
3. Did you attend or graduate from any other schools after leaving Carlisle? Give names of schools and dates if possible. I attended Haskell Institute Lawrence Kansas, nearly ~~six~~ months, I went there in Sept-1890 and returned Mar-1891. never graduated of any school.
4. What is your present occupation? I am at present employed as asst. Farmer for the Government.
5. Tell something of your present home. Well, I have a home at Colony, Okla, in Washita County and a home at my wife's allotment. Buildings on each farm. land under cultivation, some stock, and implements.
6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings or money do you have? I have 336 acres of land, six head of horses & mares, 3 buildings, 1-2 room house on my allotment and 1-3 room house on my wife's allotment. out enough money to meet my means.
7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each? Yes, I entered the Indian Service, in 1894, ^{as asst. Farmer,} and worked for 1 year, and entered the service again in 1900 as additional Farmer. held same until 1902. Jan 1-. I again entered the service in 1904 as additional Farmer and resigned in April, 1-1907. my salary as add. Farmer was \$600⁰⁰ a year.

8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle? *Sword in an*

Indian Traders store for one year.

9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life: *I have done all*

could to uphold Carlisle in any breaks made by opposing Indians. and have done as much as it could be in my knowledge to keep myself busy as I was taught while at Carlisle. My behavior has been better, as would naturally be so, the older a person gets to be. I have eight children, four attending school and four at home.
