The Indian Office at Washington has made a ruling to the effect that students must be between the ages of fourteen and twenty-one to be eligible for enrolment.

It is hoped you can make some arrangements whereby you can take up the blacksmithing trade in one of the shops in the vicinity of your home. It is a good trade and one in which there is always a good demand for competent men.

Your letter is being referred to our Print Shop and that part referring to your change of address will be given attention there.
