Sir,

After the death of Taylor Early at Schellsburg Pa we had only one Juni left, Mary Early, whose school period would expire on July 31, 1883. As the sick Navajos would be sent so near Juni, I thought it best to send her with the same party. I accordingly placed her in care of Dr. Lippencott who had charge of the party and she was safely returned to her Agency. I respectfully request your authority covering me in sending her home and her necessary traveling expenses.
