The time, place, & circumstances struck me. This child calling for help out of the midst of the old superstitions & at the time when his father was desisting himself of possession to join the Old Heathen Religion Society. I said, "I will try to see if you can go." The boy has followed me up. He reminded me of my son. & is determined to keep me company now.

Capt. Brown says Hampton can take ten, mostly girls however. I want to back in one little boy whose father gave me to me for education telling me to send the child off for as many years as I liked, only to make him thoroughly conversant with white ways. Can these Dinwiddie children go?
