Sir

I would respectfully invite your attention to the fact, that I have not yet received approval of my Reports of Irregular Employees for August and September forwarded on September 10<sup>th</sup> and October 6<sup>th</sup> respectively, also my nomination of A. J. Standing for Assistant Superintendent forwarded Sept. 18<sup>th</sup>. These approvals are necessary before forwarding my Returns for 3<sup>rd</sup> Qr 1883. In this connection, I would respectfully inform you, that in nominating Mr. Standing for Asst. Supt, I have in view, his assuming all the duties of "Supt, in charge of Shops and Property" in place of Mr. Wetzel, resigned, so that the only difference will be, the change in the designation of the place, and the increase of salary.
