Sir:-

I referred the matter of accepting a wagon each for four of the Chiefs at Rosebud, rather than a trip to Carlisle and Washington, to Agent Wright, with full explanation of your views, and am informed by him that he submitted it to White Thunder and Two Strike, and after considerable parley, they reluctantly accepted. He did not learn who the other two are, neither do I know; but Agent Wright suggests, that one should go to young Spotted Tail, and the other one to such Chief as he, Agent Wright, might select. I hope, if you grant the wagons, you will approve Agent Wright's suggestions. He states that White Thunder, in trying
