I have the honor to report that the following irregular service will be required at this School during the month of January 1886; viz - Roll of Indian Apprentices \$200.<sup>00</sup> - One Baker - no regular Baker being employed - \$15.<sup>00</sup> - One Carpenter assisting in fitting up New Dining Hall and Laundry, 26 days at \$2.<sup>00</sup> per day, \$52.<sup>00</sup> - 3 Seamstresses - \$50.<sup>00</sup> - One fireman for Steam Boilers, \$30.<sup>00</sup> - One Musical Instructor \$12.<sup>00</sup> - One Assistant Disciplinarian, assisting in care of large boys, \$10.<sup>00</sup> Amounting in the aggregate to \$369.<sup>00</sup>
