I have the honor to report that the following irregular service will be required at this School during the month of March 1886, viz: Roll of Indian Apprentices \$225.⁰⁰ - One Baker. no regular Baker employed \$15.⁰⁰ - One Carpenter, assisting in general work & repairs, 26 days at \$2.⁰⁰ per day, \$52.⁰⁰ - One fireman for steam boilers \$30.⁰⁰ - Three Seamstresses \$50.⁰⁰ - One musical Instructor, \$12.⁰⁰ - One Assistant in Laundry \$12.⁰⁰ - One Asst. Disciplinarian, assisting in care of large boys \$10.⁰⁰ - One mason, 3 days at \$2.⁷⁵ per day. \$8.²⁵. Amounting in the aggregate to \$414.²⁵.
