Sir:

The fences of the "Parker" Farm have been very much out of repair for a long time, and will require 1000 rails and 200 posts to put them in order. These will have to be purchased, as we have no timber with which to make them. Good Chestnut Rails cost \$8.⁰⁰ per hundred delivered and good mortised Locust posts cost .55 cents each. I, therefore, respectfully request your authority to purchase 1000 rails and 200 posts at prices mentioned, amounting in all to One hundred & ninety dollars (\$190.⁰⁰) -
