Sir:-

In my letter of the 14th inst. I asked that transportation for 12 pupils from the Omaha and Winnebago Agency be placed at Sioux City, subject to the order Miss Alice C. Fletcher - I mentioned Sioux City as being a good computing point and I supposed convenient; but am now informed by Miss Fletcher that it is difficult to reach, and that trains do not run at convenient hours, probably necessitating a stay over night in Sioux City as well as expense of crossing the River.

In view of the representation as made by Miss Fletcher I respectfully ask that the tickets be placed at Bancroft instead of Sioux City and that the number be increased from
