Sir.

I have the honor to state in reply to your communication of no date in reference to securing twenty first suitable children for Carlisle School, subsequently increased to forty in office letter of March 3rd 1890, that I have secured and forwarded under charge of Mrs A.A. Kennedy, authorized by Capt R. S. Pratt to attend to this duty, thirty nine pupils, six New females and twenty three boys all in good physical condition and with one or two exceptions sufficiently advanced to enter the school, in accordance with your letter I assisted them so as to present a respectable appearance upon their arrival at Carlisle.
