Replying to your letter of June 28th, marked L, 10725, authority 23470, authorizing the returning of two Crows to their Agency, Big Hail and Theron Ears, I invite your attention to the surplus of Montana Treaty Funds, in my hands, and ask if I may not from that pay the transportation of these two young men. They came here from their prison at Fort Snelling, Minn., and have been with us since July 1st, '88, and it is hardly just that our School funds should pay their transportation.
