To the Honorable,

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir:

Replying to yours of March 21st, marked "Education, 8907," granting sick leave to Miss Phillips, I have to respectfully advise you that I hope to consolidate schools at the closing months of the year and make savings to cover the irregular service rendered necessary by these sick leaves. We seem to have struck a cyclone of disability among our teachers.

Miss Phillips resigns to take effect the 31st of March, and descriptive statement covering the same, together with her resignation, goes down today. In this case, as in the former case, I request that no steps be taken to fill the place for the present, as I have some special changes to carry out. I will employ a temporary teacher.
