*Referring to your letter of Sept. 8th marked "Education 33759," covering the transfer of Lettie Connolly from this school to Lincoln Institution, Pa., I have to respectfully advise you that I feel that this transfer is not in the interests of the girl herself nor in the interests of the school service. Lettie had been the subject of discipline here and her offence was of such a nature as to make it best for her to be continued where her qualities are known. I would suggest that it is but fair that in such cases the Superintendents of the schools be informed of the reasons and given the privilege of considering them.*
