The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,



Sir:

I am very sorry to be compelled to report to you that Miss Inga M. Erickson, who has just been appointed clerk and stenographer here, has received from her old employer an urgent request to resume her old place, in which a vacancy can be arranged. The salary is \$950 per year and she feels called upon to accept of it at an early date.

Miss Peter, one of my teachers at \$720, is very satisfactory in this position, and if consistent with the rules of the service, I would request that salary of the position of clerk and stenographer here be increased to \$720; that the position of teacher of the school at \$720 be abolished and a new position at \$600 be established; that the Civil Service be called upon for one teacher to fill that place; and I be allowed to take Miss Peter into my office.
