

Sometime ago I wrote you in reference to C. D. Wheelock, who thought he was thrown out of employment at Shoshone Agency by his position having been abolished. Mr. Wheelock is a brother of Dennison Wheelock, my former band-master and James Wheelock, now employed at this school. His wife, who was Julia Powlas, graduated in the class of 1889. It appears from the letter here enclosed that she has been recommended for the position of laundress at the Shoshone School. I can only say that while here at Carlisle, Julia Powlas was a very satisfactory student and a young woman of energy and more than ordinary character.
