My dear Miss Deel

Since your visit - here a short-time since, I have thought - often of the information you let - drop regarding a possible change of ^{the} principal teacher at Chemawa.

It has become since then, a matter of greater importance that - I have a larger salary. You intimated that - I would fill the position creditably, and I have decided that - I would like to have it - if it - becomes vacant.

If there is to be no change what - would you suggest -? I especially desire the western coast, - or the south-west. Were the Riverside school in readiness I should like the task of introducing the outing system there under such regulations as exist - here, or the principal teacher's position there, should Mr. Hall decide that Miss Allen is unequal to the management - of a larger school.

Mr. Hall and I, as you know, had a most - unpleasant - misunderstanding at the time I came here, but - that has been satisfactorily explained, and I

am quite sure he would look with favor upon having me among his employees again.

I have talked with Major Pratt about the necessity for a promotion, and have mentioned the Chemawa possibility. He is kindness itself, and is willing to recommend me to the favor of the department.

I hope you are fully recovered from your cold, and are able to work more comfortably than when I last saw you.
