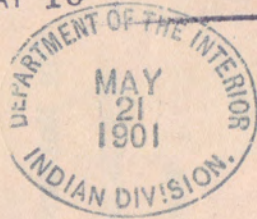


Sir:-
