Sir:

I find from examination of the accounts of Lieut. Col. Richard H. Pratt, U.S. Army, Superintendent of Indian School, Carlisle, Pa. for the Third Quarter 1901, that Voucher No. 41 represents a payment of (\$20,000.) twenty thousand dollars to Christopher C. Kutz for one hundred and seventy-five (175) acres of land more or less, known as the "Kutz Farm".

Before this payment can be properly passed to the credit of the Superintendent it is necessary that the originals or attested copies of the following papers should be furnished viz:

The opinion of the Attorney General of the United States as to the validity of the title, the certificate of the proper officer showing the Title Deed to have been properly recorded, and a copy of the Act of the Legislature of the State of Pennsylvania ceding jurisdiction over land purchased, if a special act was required, and if not, a copy of the general act for such purposes; all of which should accompany the voucher in compliance with Section 355 of the Revised Statutes of the United States.

I will thank you to forward to this office the originals or attested copies of these papers. Also the Title Deed with
