
Sir:-

Replying to your letter of the 10th marked "M 28938, I have respectfully to advise you that Howard Gansworth will go to Buffalo on the 28th inst. as you desire and remain there subject to the instructions he shall receive.

Mr. Gansworth graduated from Princeton this week with credit to himself having taken the full regular course and I shall nominate him for a position here for the ensuing year. He will be at Carlisle today and as he will have to leave here in such a short time, I will take him up and pay him on the irregular roll in place of Mr. Elmer Simon who resigned some time ago, and on his return from Buffalo, will put him into the place I intend him to occupy regularly.

I have explained to Sophia Americanhorse the objections of the Department and she takes the disappointment philosophically.
