



July 10, 1901.

It is hereby agreed by and between Lt. Col. R. H. Pratt, Supt. Indian Industrial School, Carlisle, Pa., party of the first part, and Dr. S. L. Diven, of Carlisle, Pa., party of the second part, that the said party of the second part, shall render medical service for said Indian Industrial School during the fiscal year, 1902; that he shall visit the school whenever his professional services are required, and at least three times each week for the purpose of improving the sanitary and hygienic conditions of the school generally, the said party of the second part to receive a salary of \$800.00, in quarterly payments of \$200.00 each.

It is further agreed by and between both parties hereto that this agreement is revocable upon notice of fifteen (15) days from either party or from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs.
