
Sir:-

It occasionally occurs that pupils of this school become afflicted with serious eye trouble, a tubercular affection of various organs or members of the body, or other diseases, which render it necessary that such pupils be placed under the care of a specialist for a time.

I have an arrangement with the management of the Medico-Chirurgical Hospital, Philadelphia, to treat all such cases from this school free of charge, the only expense for the pupils while in the hospital being for their board which is at the rate of \$1.00 per day.

I have the honor to request authority to expend during the fiscal year 1903, a sum not exceeding \$400.00 in payment of expenses incurred in taking pupils requiring special treatment to and from the hospital, and for their board while there; and I further request that the authority apply to an expense of \$57.00 incurred for 57 days board from April 3rd., to May 30th., for Fanny Grayman, who was undergoing special treatment for a tubercular affection of one of her feet. The bill for this expense has just arrived, too late to obtain authority for payment within the current fiscal year.
