Sir:-

During the summer months quite a number of our boys are detailed to work on our two school farms, and while so employed, they receive their board and lodging with the families of the farmers. This adds materially to the duties of the wives of the farmers. Mrs. Bennett receives a regular salary as housekeeper, but there is no authority to pay Mrs. Harlan, wife of our assistant farmer, for her services. I therefore have the honor to request authority to pay Mrs. Harlan for her services during July and August, 1903, two months, at the rate of \$25.00 per month.
