
To the Honorable,

Sir:-

Referring to application of Miss A.S.Ely for leave of absence and your letter dated Oct. 2nd., marked "Education 59418, 59625, 61469, 61660, 61951-1903" in relation thereto, I have the honor to inform you that Miss Ely was absent from duty February 26, 27, 28 and June 15, 16, 17 & 18, 7 days on account of the death of her brother, etc. The absences should have been reported to your office.

Miss Ely is therefore entitled to only 23 days annual leave with pay, from October 1 to 27 inclusive, and the remainder of the time asked for without pay.
