
To The Honorable,

Sir :

Replying to Office letter "Education 61615 - 1903" dated Oct. 1st, 1903, I have the honor to state that Supt. Potter of the Chemawa School has been written to with reference to the brother of Richard Graham and advises that if David Graham is not making satisfactory progress in the Chemawa school it is not the fault of the school.

Under the circumstances it seems best not to encourage this transfer as it appears to be only another manifestation of the spirit that possesses many Indian boys to move from one school to another merely for a change of scene.
