The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

I herewith transmit the resignation of Alice Lamar as cook at this school at \$600 per annum, the same to take effect January 20, 1905. I have to recommend that the said resignation be accepted to take effect as tendered.

I have no recommendation to make in the matter of the appointment of a cook to succeed Mrs. Lamar, and it is therefore respectfully requested that steps be taken by the Office at once to secure a cook, either by certification and appointment through the Civil Service Commission or by transfer of someone now in the service.
