

To the Honorable,
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D. C.

Sir:

I inclose herewith the resignation of E. G. Sprow, instructor in tinsmithing. Mr. Sprow has been detailed to oversee student labor in connection with excavations, etc., pertaining to our proposed new buildings. He seems to resent the fact of having been given outside work and has protested against it, and when reasoned with and shown the necessity of his outside services and told he could be better spared than any other man in charge of the shops for that purpose, has chosen to take his present course and submitted his resignation to take effect July 1st. I recommend that it take effect immediately; or, in order that he may be paid for his services until such time as notice of acceptance of his resignation is received, it will be better to have his resignation take effect June 7th.
