Sir:

Referring to Office letter "14285 F.", dated March 10th, returning contract with Mr. George Bridges of Carlisle for installation of engine, tank, tower, etc., for water system at our school farm, I have to state that the action looking to the installation of this system was deferred until it was more definitely determined that our funds would warrant the expenditure. It now appears as though we would have ample funds to have this work done, which is deemed to be real important, and the matter is presented for your consideration in connection with the clause in the contract providing for the completion of the work within sixty days from the date of approval of the contract by the Secretary of the Interior, which was March 6, 1906. Mr. Bridges has consented informally to extend the time of the contract for sixty days or until July 1st, though the necessary structural materials have increased in price since the contract was entered into. If the proposed extension of time meets with your approval please give us the necessary instructions as to the course to be pursued in making the extension effective and binding in the contract.
