
The Honorable,

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D. C.

Sir:

One of the positions of teacher at this school at \$480 per annum is and has been vacant since about the first of January, but should by all means be filled the coming year. I have no suitable Indian teacher in mind whom I could recommend for the place and do not know of one in the service whose transfer I would care to ask for. I would prefer to have the place filled by a white woman teacher and as it will probably be next to impossible to get such an employee at the present salary, I have to recommend that the same be increased to \$540 per annum, and that steps be taken without delay to have a white woman appointed thereto from the Civil Service list of eligibles, she to report here and enter upon duty by September 1st, if possible, and not later than September 4th.
