
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Sir:

Authority is requested for the payment of \$77.30 for transportation of Lewis Paul, an Alaskan, from Carlisle to Seattle, en route to his home at Wrangel, Alaska.

In addition to the above sum, there is also his steamboat fare from Seattle, but as bill for this has not yet been received, I cannot state the amount, nor place this item in the enclosed voucher. Owing to the fact that the railroads require prompt payment, and will refuse to furnish tickets unless this requirement is complied with, I am obliged to present this voucher without waiting for the balance of the fare from Seattle, and request that authority be granted with all possible speed so that I may include this voucher in my accounts for the first quarter.
