Sir:

I hereby renew my recommendation and request to have another position of assistant matron established at this school at \$480 per annum, such assistant to be detailed to help in the dining room. The services of another employe in the dining room, especially now that the school is again filled up and the attendance of pupils on the grounds is large, are very necessary. This fact was remarked and commented upon by Supervisor Frank M. Conser during his visit here last winter. During the past month one of the assistant matrons from the girls' quarters has been detailed to assist in the dining room, but this can no longer be continued without great detriment to the school, as the arrival of a large number of new and young girls renders the services of three matrons in the girls' quarters very imperative.

Your ~~fearly~~ attention to this request will be greatly appreciated and it is respectfully urged.
