The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D.C.

Sir:-

I enclose herewith resignation of Norman Egolf, dairyman. Mr. Egolf is a good practical man, but he demanded \$60.00 a month, which is \$10.00 a month more than I am willing to recommend him for another year. I therefore recommend that his resignation be accepted to take effect May 31st.

I have the honor to request that we be granted authority to employ a temporary dairyman. I have already spoken to Mr. C.W.Leib, a man who lives in this neighborhood, and who has had a great deal of experience in general farming, and whom I think will make an excellent dairyman for our purpose here under the direction of our agriculturalist, Mr. Taylor. In this connection, I want to say that it will be an advantage to have him take the civil service examination and have him appointed to the position permanently, so with that end in view, I desire that no appointment of dairyman be made for this school until I can arrange for Mr. Leib's examination in case our experience with him demonstrates that he is, as we think he will be, the proper man for the place.
