I wrote you recently that this school needed for official use the appropriation bills passed by Congress from the year 1895 to the year 1910, inclusive, and respectfully requested that I be furnished with one copy of each of these bills as soon as possible. Your office complied with my request promptly, but I find that the wrong pamphlet was sent for each of the years following: 1898, 1899, 1900, and 1905. The pamphlet sent for each of the four years just named has the following at the top of the first page:
