If your home is in California it is suggested that your daughter might be enrolled in Sherman Institute, and you might write to Mr. Frank M. Censer, Superintendent of Sherman Institute, Riverside, California. If you can furnish the proper enrollment blanks, and he is willing to receive your child, there will be no objection.

The Office is not in favor of placing California pupils in distant schools such as Carlisle, Pennsylvania.
