Referring to Office letter of November the 18th, relative to the re-enrolment at Carlisle of Richard Hinman, this is to say that I shall have no objections to his returning to Carlisle but that I believe it would not be advisable to grant him his request.

The young man was enrolled here from October of 1905 to June of this year, and our records show that he is now twenty-four years of age. He has had sufficient training in our department of painting to enable him to go to work for himself, and it is not likely that he would continue in school long enough to graduate, as he would have to complete four more years' work before completing the course.

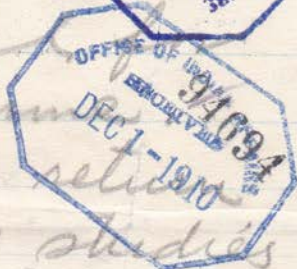
