Sir:

Referring to your endorsement of the  
11<sup>th</sup> instant forwarding for the action of  
higher authority, communication from the  
Commanding Officer, Carlisle Barracks, Pa.,  
who asks instructions in regard to the  
transfer to Lieutenant Pratt, 10<sup>th</sup> Cavalry,  
in charge of the Indian School at
