9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life:

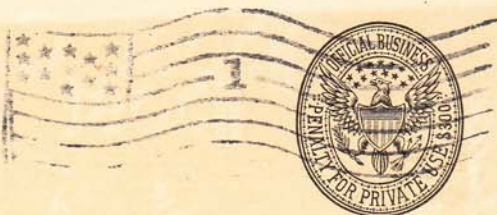
