I wish to tell you, as you
are the Supt of Carlisle School
that the Government will
do what is injustice to the
Indians of New York State.

I say this because the Indians of the said state are poor and need the training that Carlisle and other government schools give.

Our District schools does not teach us only the elementary course in academic and we have no Trade schools and that is what the Indians need the most. As to our moral character we are far from being where we should be.

The few Indians that can be well spoken off are mostly from the Government schools where everything is taught and are now making use of what they have been taught.

For the sake of those who

are poor and yet need
the help from the Govern-
ment Schools let me beg
of you to still give us the
chance to improve our work,
our thoughts, and our
lives by giving us your
instructions.
