My dear Friend:

I will acknowledge receipt of your favor of April the 4th by advising that it can be arranged to enroll your two children at Carlisle providing you pay for the transportation of the younger one. It can probably be arranged to have the girl travel at half rates and in that case the transportation would cost less than twenty dollars.

In this connection I will state that the arrangements for the enrolment of your children will have to be made thru the office of your Superintendent, but I will be pleased to give any needed assistance from this end just as soon as you are ready to send your boy and girl to us.

Dear Sir:-

I will write
a few lines, and inform you
that I am still alive in wild
world.

Supervisor Young was here and
I have a talk with him in
regards to the Day schools and
non-reservation schools.

I told him that non-reservation
is a better school for the Indians
than Day schools.

There for I want to send two
of my children to your school
next fall, boy is 14 years old
and the girl is 11 years old
and Mr. Young told me that
if I want to send my children
to non-reservation schools
before they are 14 years old

I have to pay their transportation
and so I would like to know
how it will cost me for
one, in one way.

I told Mr. Young that I want to
learn to read when I was 17 years old
and was at that school 10 years,
but I did not graduate, because
I start in too old, and that
account I want to send my
children to non-reservation
schools while they are young
so they can learn something
better than I did.
