Two images are labeled Nancy Hasholy, with her in native dress; one is of Daniel Hashorns in native dress smoking a pipe; one is of "Katonka," the character from the play "The Captain of Plymouth," played by Emma Esenetuck in 1909; one is of the Administration Building; and one is of the Dining Hall. These images were reportedly given by Richard Henry Pratt to Edna Emerick (librarian) in Rochester, NY who had arranged his visit on Thursday, Oct. 14, 1909 to speak about Carlisle. The postcards had passed to a nephew.
CIS-P-0096	1905	Stereocard published by Keystone View Company showing Geronimo and other Native American chiefs passing the review stand as part of the Inaugural Parade for Theodore Roosevelt. The Carlisle Indian School band and a troop of students are believed to be parading just behind the chiefs.
CIS-P-0097	circa 1895	Larger photo (9"x13") of the Susan Longstreth Literary Society. This image appears near the end of the school souvenir booklet printed at the school around 1895. Photo was previously owned by Marie Shatto (name written on the back), who was the mother of the donor. [Filed in oversized photo box 1.]

CIS-P-0098	circa 1907	Larger photo (11"x13.5") of the varsity track and field team. Jim Thorpe is seated in the center of the group, with Frank Mt. Pleasant to the right of Thorpe, and coach Glenn "Pop" Warner standing behind Mt. Pleasant. The two students seated to the other side of Thorpe are holding Dutch rabbits in their laps. Photo was previously owned by Marie Shatto (name written on the back), who was the mother of the donor. [Filed in oversized photo box 1.]
CIS-P-0099	Sept 1, 1917	Labor Day Weekend tourists - Three snapshots, dated September 1, 1917 (Saturday before Labor Day) of a group of three tourist visitors to the Carlisle Indian School. Image 1 shows two young men and a young woman outside the main gate; Image 2 shows the three visitors on the bridge; Image 3 shows the two young men posing with a Carlisle student on the school grounds.
CIS-P-0100	circa 1900	Small photo of an unidentified student, which seems to have been cut from a larger photo mounting that may have included other small images.
CIS-P-0101	circa 1885	Stereoscopic print titled "Band of Indian Boys at the Government School, Washington, D.C." distributed by Popular Series. The band is shown on the steps of the Superintendent's Quarters at the Carlisle Indian School.
CIS-P-0102	circa 1884	Photograph of young women working in the sewing room.
CIS-P-0103	circa 1900	Small photo of an unidentified student mounted on card.
CIS-P-0104	circa 1901	Larger photo of the band (10"x14"), posed on the bandstand. James Riley Wheelock is pictured seated to the right of the man with the conductor's baton. [Filed in oversized photo box 1.]
CIS-P-0105	circa 1875	Stereoscopic print titled "Indians at Fort Marion" featuring 17 individuals in three rows posed in uniform. A label on the back of the card mentions the prisoners of war being under the direction of Richard Henry Pratt.
CIS-P-0106	circa 1910	Three snapshots showing young women attending Sunday School classes at the home of Jane Van Ness Smead, 178 S. West St. in Carlisle. The photos were taken in the back yard of the house. Two of the photos were taken at the same time and feature 17 students, and the third photo shows 7 students.
CIS-P-0107	circa 1900	The photo may be a group of classmates or graduates. There are 34 people in the photo - 17 men and 17 women. The two women seated in the front are believed to be teachers.
CIS-P-0108	circa 1910	Postcard with the printed text "'Taps' Indian School Carlisle, Pa." The image shows a young boy in school uniform with his bugle, with another boy laying on the ground leaning against a drum. The style of the label on the image of the postcard is consistent with others produced in the school's own studio around 1910.
CIS-P-0109	circa 1915	Larger photo of a group of 46 students, possibly from the same class (graduates of 1917 maybe?). [Filed in oversized photo box 1.] Includes an additional photo not related to the school, showing a group - possibly a family gathering - around a historical plaque.

CIS-P-0124	1909	Real photo postcard featuring the graduating class of 1909
CIS-P-0125	circa 1905	Larger photo (9"x7.5") of a group of 5 band members sitting and standing among a variety of percussion instruments, including drums, xylophones, triangles, and tambourines. Written on the back is "Compliments of Spencer, Christmas," but due to the one-time framing and mounting, the date and part of the text is missing. [Filed in oversized photo box 1.]

CIS-P-0126	circa 1890	Boudoir photo of nineteen women students and one teacher on the lawn of the school grounds with the superintendent's house in the background. The handwritten caption the back reads simply "Carlisle Students." [same as NAA 73350]
CIS-P-0127	Dec. 1885	Boudoir photo of all the students assembled in the dining hall for Christmas dinner. The walls are decorated with wreaths and garland, with "Merry Christmas" on the wall on the left and "Happy New Year" on the right. The turkeys have American flags stuck in them. The handwritten caption on the back reads "Indian Students of Carlisle School at dinner, Christmas 1885."
CIS-P-0128	circa 1885	Boudoir photo of the school grounds, with the bandstand and girls' quarters in the background. Numerous people are milling about on the walkways on the bandstand. A standard Choate label appears on the back.
CIS-P-0129	1881	Three cabinet card photos featuring a collage of heads of chiefs who had visited Carlisle. Two of the cards are titled "Noted Indian Chiefs" at the top and include full busts of each of the 19 individuals and names of each identified on the back; one of those also has the text "Red Skins" on the front while the other features the J. N. Choate label. The former is inscribed on the back "Compliments of Hellen to G[faded]" The third version includes one the heads of those pictured, with the rest of their busts being airbrushed out. That copy is inscribed on the back from R. H. Pratt to Man on the Cloud (Cheyenne).

CIS-P-0132	circa 1885	Two carte de visite images: one of Samuel John, standing, wearing a suit, and holding a hat (A. L. Rogers studio) and one of an unidentified student, standing, wearing the school uniform (Dinmore studio).
CIS-P-0133	circa 1885	Four carte de visite images: one of Thomas Wistar, portrait bust, in uniform; two unidentified male students, portrait busts, in suits; and one female, portrait bust with arms crossed (may not be associated with CIS at all)

CIS-P-0138	1908	Larger photo (8.25"x11.5") of the United States Olympic Team, which features Lewis Tewanima (4th row back, 4th from left) and Frank Mt. Pleasant (2nd row back, 2nd from left) [Filed in oversized photo box 2.]

CIS-P-0147	circa 1910	Real photo postcard titled "Com. Officers, Carlisle, Pa." picturing the "commissioned" or "commanding" officers among the student body. Unsent, this card was likely created in the school's photo studio.

CIS-P-0149	circa 1900	Photo of four girls (Alaskan?), smiling, seated on the steps of a school building with a man in a hat seated with them. Two other girls can be seen on the porch behind them.
