

Mabel Stack

Date of Death: August 14, 1904

The three documents below disagree about the date that Mabel Stack died. While the letter from school staff to the Commissioner states that she died early in the morning on the 14th of August, the subsequent entry in the school's ledger and on her information card state she died on the 16th.
