Dear Sir,

I desire
to call your attention to the
agreement made by the Gov-
-nt. with the Carlisle Gas
& Water Co. (a copy of
which you will find on
file at the Garrison) which
provides that when the Gar-
-rison is occupied, the rates
for water shall be \$240.
per annum. The occupancy
of the property as an Indian
School would I presume be
equivalent to an occupancy
by troops, and the rates

the same as those named
in the agreement referred
to.
