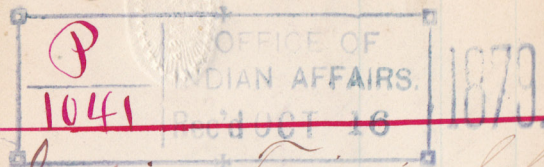

Sir,

I am in receipt of a check
for one hundred & fifteen dollars
(\$115.) from a friend to the Indian
educational work, covering the
expended for one year, of one of the
Florida Indian former prisoners, whom
with a dozen others, I propose to have
as a teacher at this school, during
the winter. Funds from like sources
will be received for the others in
due course. In a conversation with
the hon^{ble} Com^r, on this subject, some
weeks since, I was informed that
it was his desire that these funds

should be turned over to the
Civilization Fund, but I am not
clear as to the proper course, & would
respectfully request detailed in-
structions on this subject, covering
these particular cases, & also any
similar charities that may come to
me in connection with this work.
