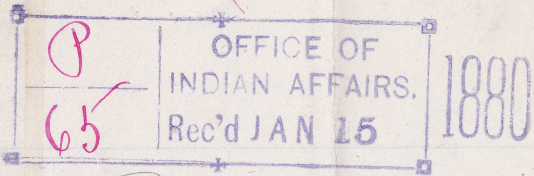

Wadville. Jan 4<sup>th</sup> 1880.

Capt Pratt.

Dear Sir, I should like  
to ask if you have need or are  
likely, to need any more teachers  
or other help in your work among  
the Indian children at Carlisle?  
I had charge of an Indian board-  
ing school at Crow Creek, Dakota  
for more than three years, & gave  
it up because of my mother's illness,  
I have been longing to engage in  
the work again & should be glad  
to do so without going so far  
away from home, (as Dakota)  
I have some knowledge of the Sioux  
language, & a deep interest in the  
Sioux & Ponca children, from personal  
knowledge of those tribes, I am deeply  
interested in the civilizing  
& Christianizing of all our Indian tribes

your work, & you have any  
vacancies, may I hope to engage
