A 320/91 Authority-197/91 received

And allow me to say that in
view of the fact you desire me
accompany some Cheyenne children
and that it is equally as near
this Agency as any other R.R. Point
& convenient for Cheyenne I will
start from Arkansas City about
Feb. 21st 1881. and have so notified
Agent Wiley of Cheyenne for the
youth of this Agency we will want
Seven @ full fare & Eight- (8) half fare

passes. Making the 15 allowance
in your letter.

Please notify me by return
mail whether above passes will
be sent to me here or at Arkansas
City. And would suggest that
they be sent to the latter point as
our mails are uncertain.

If there is no difference in the fares
I would prefer going through Chicago
as my wife wishes accompanying the
girls. And we desire to leave our
children at home. & would prefer
the Rock Island Road from Kansas
City - to Chicago. Should it be preferable
from any cause to take any other
route we will arrange for it.
The time on all leading routes...

are the same regularly.
