TRAINING SCHOOL FOR INDIAN YOUTH,

CARLISLE BARRACKS,

Carlisle, Pa., February 19 1884.

To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D.C.

Sir:

If your authority to send two pupils to the Indian Territory is given as requested by my letter of the 15<sup>th</sup> instants, I find that I shall not have sufficient "traveling expenses" funds to pay their way <sup>and</sup> that of the two already ordered to be sent to Dakota, in company of Dr. Faulkner.

It seems best that we should have money to our credit for this purpose constantly, so that if an emergency should arise we might be prepared to meet it, I would therefore request that \$300. additional be allowed to our credit for traveling expenses to be expended when authorized by the Department.
